Financial Assistance Available

FD Grant

The FD Grant provides financial assistance to qualified families demonstrating financial need, the amount of the award being dependent upon need as well as the resources available. While not all students may qualify for the FD Grant, other assistance programs may be available to families who desire an FD education for their son.

Tuition, Fees and Payment Options

Registration Fee (*Non-refundable*)

\$ 325.00

Returning students have the first opportunity to register for the upcoming school year by submitting the necessary registration forms and making full payment of the registration fee on or before Friday, March 31, 2017. Registering on or before this date assists FD in preparing for the coming school year and increases the likelihood of the student enrolling in his desired electives courses since elective course are filled on a first come first serve basis. Additionally, prompt registration offers the lowest registration fee available.

On April 1st, registration for SY 17-18 increases to \$350.00.

On July 1st, registration for SY 17-18 increases to \$400.00.

Annual Tuition

\$ 6950.00

The annual tuition for school year 2017-2018 is inclusive of operational, instructional, laboratory, building maintenance and development fund fees. In previous years, these various fees were due at different times of the year. At the request of parents and to simplify our business operations, they have been incorporated into our annual tuition.

Tuition Payment Options

Full annual tuition payment by July 15, 2017	\$ 6950.00
Semi-annual tuition payment on July 15, 2017 and January 15, 2018	\$ 3475.00
10-month installment payment plan due on or before the 15th of the month, July to April	\$ 695.00
11-month installment payment plan due on or before the 15th of the month, June to April	\$ 631.82
12-month installment payment plan due on or before the 15th of the month, June to May	\$ 579.17

Other Fees That May Apply

Other fees may be required during the school year based on the student's grade level as well as participation in clubs, activities and sports. For example:

Standardized Testing (<i>Applies to freshmen, sophomores & juniors; due September 15, 2017</i>)	\$ 45.00
Advanced Placement Exam (<i>Required for each AP exam; due March 10, 2018</i>)	\$ 105.00
Annual Parking Permits (<i>Quarterly parking permits may be purchased for \$35.00</i>)	\$ 125.00
Yearbook (<i>Applies to purchases before November 25, 2017</i>)	\$ 100.00
Graduation (<i>Applies to payments made before November 25, 2017</i>)	\$ 240.00
